Instructions:

- 1) Browse to the following web page: https://activethai.com/?go=51
- 2) Play the ActiveThai program and listen to the native Thai speaker say the word.
- 3) Always repeat the word you hear out loud, while looking at the shape of each letter. Try to identify the consonants and vowels. Say their names out loud.
- 4) Use the following pages to draw the letters of each word. Play the sound file each time you start the word again, and practice saying it several times while you are forming its shape on paper. Think about its meaning in English, or think about an object if it is a noun.
- 5) Use the other vocabulary word exercises on the website to practice identifying word tone, meaning, and spelling with your Thai keyboard. All have been designed to reinforce the learning process.
